Purpose: Evolutionism is being presented at all levels of public education and is promoted widely by the media, with very little balance or openness to opposing views. Many youth are leaving Christianity, either convinced evolution is true and God is just a crutch or habit or will use evolutionism as an excuse to leave Christianity. Children, students, and adults need to understand that science does not eliminate God. Adults need ways to help their children understand their choices. Evolutionism undermines the understanding of the Gospel in ways that you have not imagined. The primary purpose of a Genesis Seminar is to defend the Gospel and the authority of scripture. Defending the authority of the Bible and building confidence in the Scriptures will necessarily involve de-constructing evolutionary theory. The formula that evolution = science will be shown to be false.

Who should attend: Early grades through senior citizens. There will be separate sessions for middle grades, senior high and college students, and general sessions for both adults and students.

Directions from I-79

From Interstate 79, take the Bridgeville Exit which is Exit 54. Whether you are coming from the north or south, at the end of the ramp make a right turn on Millers Run Road (also called route 50). You will immediately come to the end of the road. Make a right turn onto Washington Pike. Travel for a little less than a mile and you will see Zion Lutheran Church on your left.
